✓ WHAT WE ACCEPT

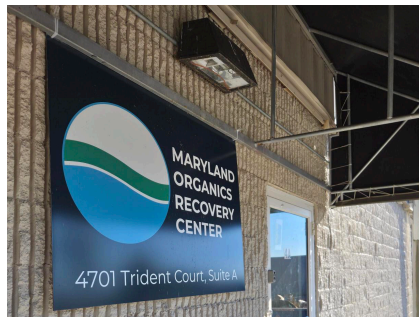
- All food waste including meat, poultry, seafood, dairy, produce, breads, pasta, dough, pet food, and food grade ingredients
